Dear Secretary Lewis:

On February 24, 2026, Jersey Central Power & Light Company ("JCP&L") submitted proposed tariff sheets to the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the "Board") describing the Direct Install ("DI") related services to be offered to public entities, providing "up to" pricing, and providing detailed pricing that will be available upon request, on a confidential basis.¹ It has come to JCP&L's attention that the previously submitted DI tariff sheets inadvertently omitted a reference to the County College Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.5(a)(8). Consequently,


¹ As background, by Order dated June 18, 2025, the Board directed JCP&L and its peer investor-owned electric and gas utilities to file tariff sheets for their energy efficiency DI programs setting forth the charges applicable to public entities (*i.e.*, local governments, public boards of education, and county colleges). JCP&L now submits proposed tariff sheets including that reference as Revised Attachment A, which replace the proposed tariff sheets provided as the original Attachment A to the February 24, 2026 filing. Apart from the addition of the reference, no other changes have been made.²

JCP&L makes this submission electronically in accordance with the Board's Order dated March 19, 2020, issued in BPU Docket No. EO20030254. No paper copies will follow.

Section 14 – Energy Efficiency Program

The following are the charges applicable to customers who must comply with the public bidding requirements set forth in the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(f), the Public Schools Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5(a)(7), and the County College Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.5(a)(8) for the measures listed below, provided to customers under the following select energy efficiency programs offered by the Company.

Direct Install - For Public Entities only

Lighting Services

Labor per fixture for interior and exterior applications, as per prevailing wages:

- Remove Fixture – up to \$400
- LED Lamp replacements with Direct Line or Ballast - up to \$385
- LED Fixture Replacement - up to \$550
- Lighting Controls - up to \$785

Lighting Systems and Materials at cost plus mark-up

Other Energy Efficiency Services

Non-lighting (*e.g.*, HVAC, controls) at cost plus mark-up, proposals will depend on specifications and site conditions.

Pricing on lighting labor by fixture type, as well as mark-ups on lighting systems and materials and non-lighting materials and labor, will be filed with the BPU annually; public entities may request pricing details on a confidential basis.

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
